The Care That Works Pilot Program needs your help to find child care providers who support trades parents by opening before 6 a.m.

Our Boston-based Pilot Program helps building trades workers find early morning child care. We provide stipends to child care providers who open early to care for children in qualified families! Your child care provider could receive additional funds to care for your child and others!

Our stipend for licensed family child care providers:

- Provides \$800 per month for the first child arriving before 6 a.m. and \$400 per month for additional children arriving before 6 a.m.
- Supports parents who meet most of these criteria: needs child care before 6 a.m., single parents, women, BIPOC, voucher-eligible, Boston residents, and in a union training or apprenticeship program.

Our Boston-based Pilot program bridges the gap between union building trades workers and early morning child care, and includes access to a network of licensed care providers.
